### Directions to site:

From The East: I88, Reagan Tollway, past Rt. 31, Aurora, to Sugar Grove exit (Rt. 56-30-47). The exit ramp becomes the road, continue west to the second stoplight - Dugan Road. Turn left onto Dugan and then bear right through the round-about onto Granart Road. Continue about five minutes to second stop sign. Turn right onto Galena Road. Show site will be on the left just past the creek.

From The North: Take I-294 to Reagan Tollway (I-88), the follow above directions.

From The South: I-55 to Rt. 126 through Plainfield to Rt. 47 (approx. 20 min.). Rt 126 dead-ends at Rt 47. Turn right going North to Galena Rd turn left and follow directions above.

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Bernese Mountain Dogs in a working capacity involving hauling. The Bernese Mountain Dog has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting from both inherent ability and training which are applicable to realistic work situations. Efficiency in accomplishment of tasks is essential. It is also desirable that the dog evidence willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.

### Class Entry Details

- There will be a limit of 24 entries for this Draft Test.
- Entry fees - \$35.00 for each Individual and Brace team with one (1) award per team. Passing brace teams will have the opportunity to purchase a second award the weekend of the test for an additional \$15.00.
- A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a brace team and then stapled together. Even though two entry forms are required for each brace team, each brace team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
- If more than 24 entries are received, they will be prioritized per the following order:
  1. Untitled BMD's
  2. Titled BMD's
  3. Untitled other dogs
  4. Titled other dogs

Note that "titled" means titled in the entered class.

- A random draw will be held for each group in the list including and following the one that causes a total entry in excess of the Test limit. Teams entered in a class in which they have already earned the advanced title will be drawn after teams without the advanced level title in that class.
- Entrants must notify the Draft Test Secretary if a dog has earned a title in the entered class, including if the title is earned after the entry has been submitted.

### Close of Entries

**Entries close at 6:00 pm, CDT, Wednesday, May 11, 2022, at the Draft Test Secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the current BMDCA Draft Test regulations.**

## Regulations

Entrants are responsible for obtaining the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations (revised as of 2011) and being familiar with them. Draft Test Regulations may be downloaded from [www.BMDCA.org](http://www.BMDCA.org) at no charge.

## Attention Exhibitors

- The following classes will be offered: Novice, Open, Brace Novice, Brace Open.
  - Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses, and tie downs or other means of securing a load on their particular draft rig. Handlers must bring their own weight. Weight will be verified via scale at the test site.
  - Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test.
  - Open and Open Brace entries must include a veterinary certificate stating the dog's name and weight. This certificate must be dated within 60 days of the date of the test.
  - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete.
1. The two dogs of a brace team need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.
  1. Un-entered dogs may be present but, like entered dogs who are not in the ring, must be leashed or crated and under control at all times.

**DWC Covid Protocols For Draft Tests**

Revised July 10th, 2021

**General Practices**

1. Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
2. Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
3. Masks only need be worn by individuals who choose to wear one, or if the state, local and/or facility guidelines require masks to be worn.
4. Anyone wishing to sanitize their own hands and/or their equipment are encouraged to do so.
5. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact without consent from the other person. All people present at the event are responsible for their own safety. Please provide your own hand sanitizer and any other supplies (i.e. masks) needed.

**Premium List**

1. List the Test Site to be used. The site needs to be available for use on the closing date.
2. Alternates can be added to the test up until and including the day before the test. If an alternate will be added to the second or third day they will need to be contacted the day/night before.
3. Additional Information
  - A COVID19 Waiver will be provided for inclusion in the Premium List. The waiver will need to be signed before an entry is complete. Any variation/edit to the waiver will have to be approved by the DWC.
  - Send the site requirements out with the final confirmation

**Prior to the Test**

1. Stay in contact with the point person for the Site. Contact the DWC if the site won't be available.
2. Stay in touch with your judges and make sure they're still comfortable raveling. Contact the DWC if there needs to be a change of judge(s).

**On Site**

3. Self check-in must be used. The handlers entry packets shall include the cart number, catalog, armband number (if used add a rubber band), binder clip, and may include a ring favor in a large ziplock-type bag and placed at their cart location. The ziplock bag shall be labeled with the handler and dog's names.
4. The secretary may request to have table in a zone marked off, which no one is to enter during the test, without the permission of the secretary.

5. The secretary will handle the clipboards as usual. The secretary and judges are responsible for cleaning anything they handle to the degree they are comfortable with. Disinfecting wipes shall be provided for the secretary's table.
6. Judges may choose to use one entrance and one exit per ring in order to keep teams from coming into close proximity to each other.

#### **Judges**

shall take care to protect teams that want to practice social distancing while they're in the ring.

#### **Handlers/Volunteers**

Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility and event guidelines. Clubs shall be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event.

- Handlers will need to be available when their equipment is being checked in. • If weight(s) for the freight haul needs to be weighed, the handler will be responsible for carrying the item(s) to the scale and back to the staging area.
- Judges will not handle any harnesses or any part of the cart other than what is needed to measure the cart.
- For the Recall Exercise the handler will take the leash with them and not hand it to a judge. Awards & Scoresheets

#### **Awards and Scoresheets –**

Ribbons/Trophies are to be available for the handlers to get them themselves, should they choose to.

#### **Other**

- The guidelines shall be followed in the ring and test area, to include the draft ring, secretaries table, equipment area, hospitality area (if there is one) and the Freight Haul activity, not the entire site. A Last Word
- At all times, and especially when in doubt, do what will not cause harm to you or those around you!
- Take charge of yourself and if you need to take extra precautions for your comfort level, please do so.
