#### Notice to Exhibitors

- A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the event secretary if your bitch is in season.
- Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog. Refunds allowed as stated above will be processed as follows: Checks will not be returned, they will be shredded following the event. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded in the case of duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing of entries.
- Entries sent via Express Mail must have the signature waived.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Owners or their agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Please bring your own chairs, water for yourself and your dog.
- Food will not be available at event, but there are fast food restaurants nearby.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times. No flexi-type retractable leashes allowed.
- Unentered dogs are not allowed in the test area.
- Porta potty will be available on site.
- NO alcoholic beverages are allowed at the event site.
- No telephone, fax, online entries or credit card payments will be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BMDCNI Treasurer will add a \$35 collection to the amount of each returned check.
- Neither the event committee, nor the BMDCNI will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the event
  grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the
  test is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the event
  premises.
- Owners or their agents are responsible for any injury or death to livestock including but not limited to veterinary bills, and/or the cost of replacement of said animal.
- Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and Edy condition.
- Title application forms will be available day of test. Owner is responsible for submitting completed form with AKC fee of \$30 to receive title certificate.
