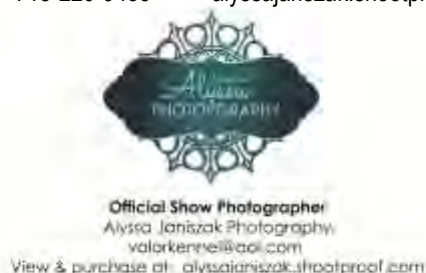

- 1) All fees for **conformation and obedience**: Include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. Fees for **rally** include the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Note: There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.
- 2) Please note that rally is a separate event from the specialty (conformation & obedience); therefore, you must pay the first entry fee (not the additional entry fee) if you also are entering in conformation or obedience.
- 3) Fee for **4-6 Month Beginner Puppy** includes the \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee per entry.

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PLEASE NOTE:

Bitches in Season: If a bitch entered in the obedience or rally classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, the entry will be fully refunded.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY – SATURDAY & SUNDAY

(NOT Divided by Sex) (Entry Fee, Per Day, for 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy is \$25.00)

For dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the day of the event.

- AKC registration # or an AKC litter # is required.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies).
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – SATURDAY & SUNDAY

NO AGE DIVISIONS – All ages will show together in each respective class
(Entry Fee, Per Day, for Junior Showmanship is \$10.00 if not entered in any other class – FREE as an additional entry)

(Note: additional information required on back of entry form)

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won their three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler

AKC OWNER-HANDLED SERIES – SATURDAY & SUNDAY

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

- ❖ Professional handlers, household members & current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- ❖ Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- ❖ The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- ❖ Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- ❖ Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series through the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition & subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- ❖ The Owner/Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. *This excludes all dogs defeated during class & winners competition for the regular show.*

- NO ENTRY SHALL** be made or accepted which specifies any condition to its acceptance.
- ENTRIES SHALL NOT** be accepted without signature and fees. All entries must be on official AKC entry forms.
- ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts, including extreme weather conditions, beyond the control of the management; it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry shall be made.
- POST-DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BMDNCI will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. If acknowledgement of entry is not received by exhibitor within a reasonable period of time, please notify the show secretary.
- NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
